

One-Week All-Weather Emergency Yard Camping Supplies for Two Persons

Store outside, in case earthquake or other emergency leaves residence briefly uninhabitable.

50-gallon sealed plastic storage tub contains:

- 1 – Survival handbook, that also addresses local animal/plant/insect dangers (in zip-locked plastic bag)
 - 12 – Individual MRE [Meal Ready to Eat] kits of freeze dried food
 - 28 – Individual plastic one-pint screw-cap bottles of drinking water (*to liquefy drinks in the MRE kits*)
 - 1 – Multi-purpose camp scissors
 - 1 – Small bottle of DEET insect repellent lotion
 - 1 – Box of wooden kitchen matches (in zip-locked plastic bag)
 - 6 – 16oz propane fuel cylinders
 - 1 – Propane cylinder screw-on 3,000btu heater
 - 1 – Propane cylinder screw-on one-mantel light
 - 1 – Propane cylinder screw-on one-burner stove
 - 2 – Wide-mouth enameled stainless steel campfire mugs
 - 1 – Mechanical can opener
 - 1 – Stainless steel stirring spoon
 - 1 – One-quart aluminum hang-handled pot with pot cover
 - 1 – 5” serrated kitchen utility knife
 - 2 – 14”x10” acrylic cutting boards (*doubles duty as serving trays*)
 - 1 – 25sq. ft. roll of aluminum baking foil
 - 1 – Small folding camp shovel
- 40 – Plastic extra-strong kitchen trash bags
 - 1 – Roll toilet paper (in zip-locked plastic bag)
 - 1 – Folding camp toilet
 - 6 – Reusable/disposable cloth hand towels
 - 1 – Small bottle of liquid camp soap (in zip-locked plastic bag)
 - 2 – Terrycloth bath towels (*if rolled a towel doubles duty as a pillow*)
 - 2 – Travel toothbrushes (in zip-locked plastic bag)
 - 1 – Large rainwater-bailing sponge
 - 1 – Small two person inflatable raft (*use as a cool-off pool, or to stretcher supplies to higher-ground*)
 - 1 – Small tube of SPF30 sun blocking lotion
 - 2 – Cheap sunglasses
 - 2 – 84”x35” plastic “astronaut” insulating body-bag
 - 2 – Wool blankets
 - 2 – 80”x52” lightweight plastic ponchos
 - 1 – Plastic “space blanket” for use as a floor
 - 1 – Plastic opaque 12’x12’ grommet holed tarpaulin
 - 1 – 50’ cotton clothes line
 - 1 – Plastic tube tent
 - 1 – Small roll gaffers tape
 - 1 – Small notepad of writing paper (in zip-locked plastic bag)
 - 1 – Ballpoint ink pen
 - 1 – Deck of plastic coated playing cards
 - 1 – Plastic travel board game with magnetic pieces
 - 1 – Small travel mirror
 - 2 – Whistles with lanyards
 - 1 – Battery powered area lighting tent lamp
 - 1 – Set of batteries for the battery powered area lighting tent lamp
 - 2 – 15 minute red highway flares
 - 1 – Rechargeable solar/dynamo AM/FM radio with built-in flashlight
 - 1 – Medium sized first-aid & snake-bite kit

Each person should supplement this tub with a long-legged pant, a long-sleeved shirt, two pair tube-socks, a compact pair of shoes (such as water shoes), and personal necessities (such as spare eyeglasses).
