

Your emergency evacuation toiletries backpack is intended to provide basic hygiene tools until reaching the evacuation site specified by authorities. Although stand-alone, it is recommended that this backpack be used in conjunction with an “Ark III” 3 day food-water-blanket survival kit.

Kit includes:

- 12 Degradable human waste bags
- 1 4 oz drinking/washing water in sealed tear-pack
- 1 Washcloth
- 1 1 oz waterproof SPF15 sunblock lotion
- 1 1 oz petroleum lip/skin jelly
- 12 Double-tipped cotton swabs in a one quart plastic ziplock freezer bag
- 1 Pocket-sized hand mirror
- 1 Disposable waterproof orange poncho
- 1 Twelve-hour chemical light stick on a string

- 1 One gallon plastic ziplock freezer bag containing:
 - 1 Roll of strong toilet paper
 - 4 Feminine hygiene compress pads
 - 12 Individually packed sanitizing alcohol moistened tissues
 - 1 Travel toothbrush in protective handle case
 - 1 Roll of dental floss in dispenser
 - 1 Package of 12 Wint-O-Green real-sugar breath mints
 - 1 Travel sized solid gel antiperspirant and deodorant
 - 1 Eyeglass retaining string
 - 1 Collapsible plastic cup with cover
 - 1 \$10 Roll of US Quarters
 - 12 Waterproof wood matches in scratchpad matchbox
 - 1 Tea candle
 - 1 Emergency can and bottle opener
 - 1 Whistle on a lanyard
 - 1 Swiss army: pen knife, file with screwdriver tip, scissors, and preferably removable toothpick and tweezers

Note that this backpack should be stored packed and ready in a cool and dry, but readily accessible location within your primary residence. If possible, keep another at your primary place of work. There are no batteries or other items with expiration dates in this backpack. If you have the time, take with you on the evacuation extra clothing, a working flashlight, and personal items such as eyeglasses and identification.
